Timberwolves Forward/Center Karl-Anthony Towns

On how the team should look at this game...

"I think we characterize this game as a point in the road that we have to look back and we have to understand and grow from this. We held them to, I think, 33 points in the first half. That's very good for us to do. We've got to do a better job from here on out, especially in the third quarter. Instead of losing by one point, we need to win by more than just one or two. We need to make sure we come out of halftime with the same intensity, energy and focus that we had in the first half."

On playing against Embiid...

"Those are the ones you look forward to. Going against a great, talented player. Someone who's going to be in this league for a long time who you're going to be seeing for a long time. Get a chance to go out, compete and just have fun. Those are the fun matchups."
