Timberwolves Center Karl-Anthony Towns

On blowing a double-digit lead...

"We keep building great leads and it seems like we keep having half the puzzle done and we don't finish the puzzle. We've got to go back to the drawing board tomorrow. Got to get ready for the next game. We have a great opponent in OKC and we've got to make sure we're totally ready and we've got to finish the puzzle."

On similarities to other losses this season...

"Every game has a different philosophy. We have to do little things and we just didn't do them in the right time. We got relaxed. We can't do that. We can't be undisciplined with our games and we can't be undisciplined with the lead."

On the team's effort...

"It's a team effort. Today maybe a little bit like that, but I don't see it like that. I think it was a team effort. We all made mistakes defensively and offensively that could have helped us win the game. From the biggest ones to the littlest ones, this is a team sport. This is not an individual sport. It takes five to win."

On the team's third quarter struggles...

"Yeah. That third quarter is just haunting us right now. I don't know what it is. I don't know what's happening. We just can't keep coming out like that. I don't know what it is, but we're going to figure it out."

On if the team becomes too individual when they fall behind...

"You can say that. I feel like our team is full of leaders and people that want to take the initiative to get the team going again. I feel like that's what a lot of people want to do. We know what happens. We just need to get through it together. We can't always depend on one or two people, we know that. It has to be a unit. It has to be a team and not really on the offensive end, but the defensive end. We're not scoring, but we need to make sure they're not scoring. It's like that."

On the feeling when Denver started to make its run...

"Yeah, at the end of the first. I feel like we just react like we're too comfortable. Like they couldn't come back. They're a good team. They've got some good players on their team and they made a run for it, and they got confident."
