TEAM NOTABLES

- With tonight's victory, the Nets improved to 3-4 in the regular season and 3-2 at Barclays Center, while the Timberwolves fell to 1-5 with the loss.
 - Tonight's game marked the first game in a back-to-back set for Brooklyn. The Nets will play the Knicks at Madison Square Garden tomorrow night (7 p.m. EST).
 - The Timberwolves also played the first game in a back-to-back set tonight and will travel to Orlando to play the Magic tomorrow night (7 p.m. EST).
- Brooklyn scored a season-high 54 points in the paint tonight, edging the Timberwolves 54-42.
- The Nets shot a season-best .553 (42-of-76 FG) from the field and a season-best .885 (23-of-26 FT) from the free-throw line tonight vs. Minnesota.
- Brooklyn's bench outscored the Timberwolves' reserves 46-28 in the win, led by 14 points from **Sean Kilpatrick** and 11 points from **Joe Harris**.
 - Entering tonight's game, the Nets bench was averaging 44.7 points per game, which ranked second in the league behind the Lakers (50.6 ppg).

PLAYER NOTABLES

- **Brook Lopez** scored 26 points (10-of-16 FG, 3-of-7 3FG) with a season-high three blocks in 28 minutes tonight.
 - In his last three games, Lopez has shot .429 (9-of-21 3FG) from long range. In his first three games of the season, Lopez shot .143 (1-of-7 3FG) from long range.
 - Lopez also moved past **Vince Carter** into sole possession of third in franchise history in free throws made (1,947) with his first made free throw tonight.
- **Rondae Hollis-Jefferson** scored in double figures for the second consecutive game, recording a season-high 13 points tonight for Brooklyn with four rebounds and two assists.
- **Isaiah Whitehead** dished out a career-high seven assists (and just two turnovers) with seven rebounds in 26 minutes in his second career start for Brooklyn.
- **Bojan Bogdanovic** scored 13 points and moved into a tie with **Mirza Teletovic** for 10th in Nets history in threes made (235) with his third made 3-pointer tonight.
- **Joe Harris** totaled 11 points in 23 minutes off the bench tonight, making his third game scoring in double figures for the Nets this season (he scored in double figures three times in 56 career games with Cleveland).
